Answers: 1. Lady Diana Spencer. She was known as "The People's Princess" and tragically passed away in an automobile accident on August 30, 1997. 2. Medicare. The act amended the Social Security Act, which became law in 1935. 3. The (full) buck moon. The moon gets this name from the male deer (buck), which in July is in its final month of antler growth. The antlers regrow each year, often slightly bigger than the year prior. 4. Bastille Day. It commemorates the storming of the Bastille in 1789, which sparked the French Revolution. 5. Tab. It was introduced with the tagline "How can just one calorie taste so good?" It debuted in 1963 and was discontinued in 2020.

Celebrating with a Bang!

Parades, picnics, barbecues, music, and most of all, fireworks, make the Fourth of July a special celebration across the country. Since 1976, New York City has had the largest fireworks display. Sponsored by Macy's, it an explosive extravaganza with more than 22 tons of colorful pyrotechnics exploded over the East River. The Boston Pops Orchestra's yearly music and fireworks celebration over the Charles River Esplanade in Boston has been televised nationally since 1973. And, of course, fireworks on the Capitol lawn in Washington, D.C., typically attract more than a half a million people. Detroit celebrates with its Canadian sister-city Windsor, Ontario, commemorating the Fourth of July and Canada Day (July 1) in a blowout called the International Freedom Festival. Fireworks ignited on barges floating on the Detroit River between the two cities create a fitting and spectacular end to the celebration.
